MANAGER'S REPORT

After a good win last week we were confident going into this Sunday's game against old rivals Broxbourne Rangers Old Boys with only three team changes. We started confidently but created and missed several chances before Conor McGovern volleyed in to give us the lead after an excellent move involving Danny Hagan, Kizza and Lexton Harrison. Unfortunately, we were caught on the break and conceded an equaliser before half time when a cross from an acute angle deceived Darryl at the near post. Early in the second half we conceded a rare goal from a corner when the loose ball fell to an unmarked forward for an easy finish. Broxbourne have been a bit of a bogey team for us over the years and as we created and missed several more chances I was getting worried. However, a superb far post volley by Conor from Terry Moore's long pass gave us an equaliser in the 66th minute.
