#### **MANAGER'S REPORT**

I was able to name a squad of 16 for our league match against Broxbourne Rangers Old Boys. Centre back Terry Moore was the only regular player missing and with Dean Assiamah and Lexton Harrison arriving before the kick off and stalwarts Stuart Dorward and Conor McGovern available we fielded a very strong starting eleven. Although we had a lot of possession in the first half Broxbourne defended very deep and we struggled to create many clear cut chances. It was a bobbly pitch which did not suit our passing game. Goalkeeper, Simon Jackson has been advocating the Stoke City approach in such circumstances and he was proved right when Lexton's long throw was flicked on by Conor for Danny Hagan to score a rare headed goal after 61 minutes. We almost lost the lead just a minute later when Broxbourne hit the post but a long clearance to Lexton saw him outstrip the defender and fire an excellent shot into the far corner. I felt that at 2-0 we would see the game out comfortably so made a triple substitution to give all the squad a game. It almost backfired as Broxbourne had their best spell of the game forcing several corners, hitting the bar and forcing Jacko into a fine save. However, one of the substitutes, Danny Smith then scored our third goal to secure our win. In fact, we should have scored more after that as Lexton missed an open goal after rounding the keeper and other chances went begging but we were happy with a 3-0 win to move us into mid table.
