MANAGER'S REPORT

Following last Sunday's win against Premier Division side Larsens we had another tough friendly arranged against KOPA league side Cetinkaya Cinar. Again our opposition arrived early with an impressive bench full of substitutes whilst we struggled to get eleven players to the kick off time.
