MATCH REPORT.... After a frustrating waterlogged pitch postponement for what would have been a rare Home game the week before, we were fortunate that most of our players made themselves available for this afternoon kick-off at Highlands School's 3G pitch in Enfield against a Colney Hatch Athletic side who we failed to beat in three attempts last season despite us having plenty of chances to do so. We did however have to put midfielder Josh Wakeford in goal again as his father Tim was unable to get back in time from working abroad, but with Dapo Alaoye and 27-year-old Tre Maxwell both on the bench, we still had plenty of good options in the centre of the pitch to replace Josh there anyway. Unfortunately though, Colney Hatch Athletic were fielding a strong squad of 16 themselves which included all their best attacking players, and it was the division's current leading scorer Avi Kabrielian who gave them the lead from the penalty spot after just 7 minutes after Natan Pawlaczyk had rushed into a challenge to try and clear the danger after defensive mistakes from others. It then got worse for us five minutes later when Amir Mohsenifar made it 2-0 with a close-range finish from the rebound after Kabrielian had got in behind Natty from a long throw to test keeper Wakeford and then we had to make an enforced substitution in the 17th minute when Harry Dorward limped off with a nasty looking ankle injury which could well see him sidelined for a while. Although we were creating plenty of chances ourselves, we then found ourselves 3-0 down in the 26th minute when Avi Kabrielian outwitted Leon McKenzie-McKay to get in a low cross to the far post for his brother Aren to tap in and at that stage with Colney Hatch having managed to get all seven of their shots on target so far, we could have been looking at a repeat of our defeat to Armenian Youth when they did likewise and ended up scoring 15. However, we had a bit of luck in the 31st minute when Tairique Harrison's free-kick squirmed in under keeper Bhavik Somani and through a hole in the net which could have easily fooled the Referee, and we then played our best football of the season so far for the rest of the First Half with Tairique making it 3-2 after 34 minutes with a towering header from Myreon Keane's perfect cross and Gianni Dipo then prodding home a loose ball in the area for an equaliser just 18 seconds later. The Second Half was very different though with much fewer clear-cut chances for either side, but we should have gone on to win after Colney Hatch were reduced to 10 men in the 71st minute when forward Aren Kabrielian was sent off for apparently grabbing Myreon Keane round the neck in an off-the-ball incident. However, Avi Kabrielian managed to win the game for his side instead when he made it 4-3 with 12 minutes to go after catching Daniel Schwartz-Gee in possession. Once again though for the third match in a row it was a very close game and there are definite improvements all the time.
