MANAGER'S REPORT

We faced a tough cup tie against Division One rivals Flamstead End on Sunday but we were fielding a strong squad with three good substitutes. Unfortunately Lexton Harrison was late again and I had to re-arrange the starting eleven with Steve Cokell partnering Terry Brown up front. We had the first chance of the match when Danny Hagan blasted over the bar from 6 yards. Typically, we then fell behind after 10 minutes when a deep cross was headed in at the far post from Flamstead End's first chance. The rest of the half was fairly even with few clear cut chances for either side but we defended solidly and played some good passing football going forward. In the 57th minute both sides were reduced to 10 men when Rob Brown retaliated to a stray elbow in the face. This affected our attacking play as Danny Hagan and Stuart Dorward could not get forward as much to support our forwards. Lexton came on to strengthen us up front but he was well marked and we struggled to create chances. We went 2-0 down with 20 minutes to go when a rebound off the bar was headed in. Stuart Dorward pulled a goal back after a good run with 2 minutes to go but with less than 2 minutes stoppage time played we ran out of time to force an equaliser.
