MANAGER'S REPORT

Our London Junior Cup tie against London Maccabi Lions 'B' was the only match played in our league due to a 9.30 a.m. kick off on a 3G artificial pitch. The snow had all melted and waterlogging was not a problem. Everyone turned up on time for the early kick off but the way we played in the first half indicated that most of our players were still asleep. Despite a perfect playing surface our passing was very poor. Lions had the best of the chances although most of them came from our mistakes. Fortunately, Simon Jackson was in good form in goal to keep the score at 0-0. Our best chance was just before half time when Ben Keating hit the rebound high over the bar following a save from Riaz Daniels' free kick. We played a lot better in the second half which was a much more even affair. However, both teams struggled to create clear cut chances and extra time and penalties was looking to be the likely outcome. In the 92nd minute we were awarded a free kick on the half way line for a push on Riaz Daniels and we pushed men forward as Terry Moore took the long free kick. Presumably under pressure the Lions defender headed the ball backwards into the net giving the keeper no chance and we took the lead. There was only time for one attack by the Lions before the final whistle blew and a 1-0 win took us through to the quarter finals.
