#### MANAGER'S REPORT

We reached the London Junior Cup Quarter Final with four wins and only one goal conceded. It was unfortunate that our captain, Danny Hagan, was unavailable due to his broken hand being in plaster although he did make the journey to West London to support the team against Middlesbrough Supporters. I still had a strong squad to choose from with Jack Bangs, Krishan Singh and John Scouller named as the three substitutes. Unfortunately, we got off to the worst possible start as Simon Jackson was penalised by the referee for handball outside of the area as he took a drop kick despite the fact that the neutral linesman didn't flag. Jacko was then cautioned for dissent and the free kick went straight in to put us behind after 3 minutes. It was very early so we had plenty of time to get back into the game but we went 2-0 down after 11 minutes in what seemed to be their next attack. Further goals after 14 and 21 minutes saw us 4-0 down from 4 chances. Riaz Daniels pulled a goal back with a good finish from Younis Jouied's through ball and it was still only half way through the first half so an amazing comeback was still on. However, every time Middlesbrough went forward they scored with further goals after 31, 35 and 38 minutes for an incredible 7-1 half time scoreline. After persuading Jacko that it wasn't 'all his fault' and encouraging everyone to keep their heads up we changed our formation and came out with a positive attitude. Almost immediately in the second half, Middlesbrough had another chance but Jacko made a fine save. Thereafter, they hardly got in our half. We forced numerous corners and had plenty of possession but were unable to pull any goals back. All three of our substitutes came on but we still couldn't score before a breakaway in the 85<sup>th</sup> minute saw a foul by Jacko lead to a 2<sup>nd</sup> yellow card and a penalty. Riaz Daniels went in goal but the penalty was well taken into the bottom corner and the game finished in a heavy 8-1 defeat.
