**MATCH REPORT...** Having lost the first match of this Double-Header, we really needed at least a point from this second match with only one game remaining this season after this one and with four points in total needed to guarantee finishing outside the bottom two in the division. Player-Manager Josh Wakeford therefore decided to start this second match with the same eleven that finished the first game, but we still had four players in our squad of 14 who had not played for months in addition to the whole team only having played two matches in the past 10 weeks, so despite our fitness levels being good because of our average age of only 20, the lack of match practice and teamwork was always going to be a problem when we were up against a Shentree side who were going for the League title and had been playing every Sunday pretty much all season. With Shentree's players all turning up week-in, week-out and full of confidence, it was no surprise that this second match continued where the first one left off and we came under the cosh straight away with Shentree creating several chances in the first 15 minutes before Chris Jordanou brought down Keelan Socratous for a penalty after being caught in possession from a short goal-kick. Ton Mazzone then comfortably converted from the spot to put his side 1-0 up, and when Chris made another bad mistake (after going to watch Spurs do likewise the evening before) to gift Shentree a second goal through the onrushing Santino Napolitano just 10 seconds after the re-start, it seemed like we would be in for a severe thrashing. However, our players continued to work hard and we managed to come off at Half-Time with no further damage. We then had a good start to the Second Half with Christian Ellis pulling a goal back in the 36<sup>th</sup> minute with a far post volley after a strong run and excellent cross from Myreon Keane and we almost made it 2-2 just a minute later when Rashawn Bennett-Dyer hit a long-range free-kick towards the top corner, but Shentree keeper Bolly Williams...another near 7-foot tall giant...had the height and reach to tip it away. We then continued to look the better side as those two chances gave us a boost, but Shentree then made it 3-1 in the 51<sup>st</sup> minute from their first on-target shot of the half, but James Themistokleous looked well offside in running onto a through ball to sidefoot past Josh with ease. Referee Pieri...a former school-teacher for half our players...turned down our heated protests though while Shentree immediately brought on three badly out-of-shape substitutes for the last 9 minutes as if they had won the game easily...which they really hadn't as we had certainly given them a much closer game than we did in the first match. We now need to beat Omonia Youth Seconds in our final match of the season to avoid relegation and send Omonia down instead.
