#### MANAGER'S REPORT

We lost 6 points this week with Wormley Rovers dropping out of the league which resulted in our two wins against them being expunged from the records. Sunday's match against local rivals, St Mary's was now a vital relegation battle. Although they only had a bare eleven St Mary's appeared to have a strong side out including ex Rovers' player Micky Southam. We had two Sunday morning drop outs leaving us with a squad of twelve and Martin Loveday was again needed to play through the pain barrier in defence. The game was fairly even early on with a bobbly pitch making passing difficult. After 22 minutes St Mary's went down to 10 men as one of their players sustained an injury. Strangely they kept two up front and only 3 in midfield against our 5 man midfield. This saw us start to dominate possession. We took the lead after 34 minutes through a route one goal with Jacko's clearance flicked on by Danny Smith for Conor McGovern to lob over the keeper. Conor scored again in the 61<sup>st</sup> minute after a break with Stuart Dorward and completed his hat trick following a corner in the 68<sup>th</sup> minute. A comfortable 3-0 lead allowed me to rest Martin Loveday and bring on substitute John Scouller. Micky Southam pulled a goal back for St Mary's with a good finish, much to the disgust of Simon Jackson who was desperate for another clean sheet. In the 85<sup>th</sup> minute Terry Moore made a rare appearance in the opposing half to set up John Scouller for some silky skills and an emphatic finish to seal an excellent 4-1 victory.
