**MANAGER'S REPORT**

Our last match of the season was against Turnford Geese on Easter Sunday and despite Laurence's fears of a non fulfilment due to the bank holiday only John Scouller was required to work. Unfortunately, Stuart Dorward and Conor McGovern were unavailable for the last match before they retired. However, a squad of 14 all arrived before the kick off which allowed me to field a strong team with three substitutes. It turned out to be a close game with both defences on top although we believed that we created the better chances in a goalless first half. It was a similar pattern in the second half until we went behind after 65 minutes when a long ball from the half way line took a high bounce off the hard pitch and deceived Simon Jackson in goal. I was able to bring on all three substitutes towards the end as we pushed for an equaliser and we created a couple of half chances. Typically, we then suffered two injuries to defenders Rob Brown and Martin Worthington and had to play the last 5 minutes with 9 men. In the 94<sup>th</sup> minute Terry Moore seemed to have timed his tackle perfectly but the referee gave a penalty which was scored to make the final score 2-0. It was a disappointing result to end the season particularly as it was a decent performance which deserved at least a draw.
