Report: Although White Hart had only lost twice in 18 matches so far this season, we were very *confident* before this match until we got to the venue and found out that both Neil Tilley ('too tired') and Glen Southam ('ill - in bed') wouldn't be playing, and from that point onwards everything started to go wrong as we found ourselves 2-0 down after only 18 minutes, Shaun O'Neill had to play practically the whole match with a pulled thigh muscle and John Beasley had to be carried off and taken to hospital after an horrendous-looking challenge on his knee from a White Hart defender. With Kevin Dedman missing the game through work commitments we were always short of enough firepower up front to be in contention even if we did pull two goals back late on in the match after being 4-0 down at one stage. However, the main difference between the two sides was that White Hart were fielding a full-strength and settled side with excellent teamwork, whereas once again we had to field eleven *individuals* who do not yet know enough about each others games, mainly because we have too many players who cannot play every week.
