

ROVERS MATCH POSTPONEMENTS (First Team Only)

SEASON 1976-1977

* We played in a Youth League in our first season and games were not arranged every week due to school holidays.

EDMONTON SUNDAY LEAGUE

- *For teams who did not have a League match on any particular date, the Edmonton Sunday League arranged a Supplementary Cup competition which gave every team a fixture every week, so that is why there were very few 'No Match Arranged's listed compared to the other two Leagues we played in.*
- *Games being called off for waterlogged pitches were rare in comparison to nowadays because there was no compensation culture for injuries caused by the ball getting stuck in a puddle. If there were one or two large puddles on the pitch (like the one we have a problem with at Hazelwood nowadays), we would just play round them or the players would get a broom and sweep the water away before the kick-off (or just use their boots to kick the water away as much as possible). Games would only be called off if the **whole pitch** was flooded. Also, any lines that had washed away would be re-marked out by a Council groundsman just before the kick-off on a Saturday or a Sunday morning instead of in midweek (as is the case now).*
- *Games would only be called off for frozen pitches if there were dangerous large frozen divots all over the pitch. If there were only one or two or the pitch was reasonably flat, then the game would be played. Again, no compensation culture for injuries caused by frozen pitches in those days.*
- *Matches in our Edmonton Sunday League days would be arranged for every Sunday apart from Christmas Day or Boxing Day. Council groundsmen were employed for every other day of the year, including New Year's Day ! (We played a League match on New Year's Day in the 1977-1978 Season).*
- *In the late-70's/early-80's, teams in the Edmonton Sunday League used numerous different venues but Enfield Council kept the goalposts up for most of them well into May. The season always ended in mid-May and teams played almost twice as many matches during the course of a season as they do nowadays. Pitch fees were really cheap because they were all being used every week with few postponements. Players did not have to pay as much subs and could therefore afford to play every week.*

* We withdrew from the Edmonton Sunday League in January 1984 in protest at a League Committee decision to expel our Reserve Team, so we only played half a season and then just played the occasional Friendly between January to April. (Not worth counting the postponements).

HARINGEY SUNDAY LEAGUE

- *Like the Edmonton Sunday League, the Haringey League did not allow their teams to enter County Cup competitions, but unlike the Edmonton League, the Haringey League did not arrange Supplementary Cup matches to replace those missing County Cup games/weeks without a League match, hence the increased number of 'No Match Arranged'.*
- *This was when we first started using Hazelwood as a Home pitch and we were then unable to play at Home in the first two weeks of September and the last three weeks of April due to cricket being played over there. This also increased the number of 'No Match Arranged's for us.*
- *An Enfield Council groundsman was employed at Hazelwood all throughout our Haringey League days where he worked at the ground Mon-Fri 9-5 and rolled, forked, sanded and marked out the pitches over there. Every park in the Borough had a 'parkie' in those days to do those jobs ! Enfield Council also employed 'parkies' to open up the changing rooms and do the same jobs on Saturdays and Sundays as well, although they couldn't do anything about the snow that caused postponements in the mid-80's of course.*

- *The above season was really frustrating because the husband & wife team who were running the Haringey League at the time moved to live on the South Coast but still tried to run the League from there...and of course it was in the days before mobile phones and the internet. The League started falling apart with teams not turning up to fixtures and matches not being arranged when they could have been. We left the League at the end of the season as did many other teams, and the League eventually folded.*
- *This was also when Enfield Council starting laying off their Mon-Fri 9-5 'parkies' and only employing groundsmen to open up the changing rooms on Saturdays and Sundays. They would still mark the lines out and do pitch inspections on Saturdays and Sundays, but grass-cutting during the week would get left and from this season until the late-90's when Broomfield (the Saturday AFA Club who share our pitch) started forking, rolling, sanding & cutting the pitch/grass, we invariably played our Home matches on a badly-churned up pitch with ridiculously long grass that made it hard for us to pass the ball. The Council groundsmen still allowed a lot of games to go ahead on pitches that would have been called off waterlogged nowadays though.*

WALTHAM SUNDAY LEAGUE

- *Our entry into the Waltham Sunday League in the late-80's saw us encounter new problems, one of which was having matches postponed due to **no Referee** being available. In our previous two Leagues, matches often went ahead with a club official taking charge whenever that happened, but the Waltham League...sensibly in my opinion, did not allow that. There was always a problem with a shortage of Referees in the 70's, 80's and early-90's because 11-a-side adult football was so popular there were not enough Referees to go round. Nowadays there are more Referees than teams in the Waltham League because they are paid ridiculous amounts in comparison to what they used to be and of course there are hardly any teams and Leagues left !*
- *Another problem we started encountering during the 1990's was **pitch booking cock-ups**. This started happening with the advent of the internet, probably because League officials, council employees and Club Secretaries didn't know how to use a computer and/or (later on) mobile phones.*

- *This was when the compensation culture started to kick in with local Councils calling off matches as soon as a puddle appeared on a pitch for fear of somebody injuring themselves and then suing the groundsman. It was also when Enfield Council made further cutbacks and stopped groundsmen marking out pitches on Saturdays and Sundays when the lines had been washed away by rain in midweek.*

- *This is when Enfield Council started cutting back even more by only utilising groundsmen on a Thursday each week to inspect pitches and mark the lines out. That meant if a pitch was waterlogged or snow-bound on a Thursday and the lines could not be marked out at that time, then the following weekend's matches (on both the Saturday and Sunday) would be called off on the Friday morning. Of course invariably, by a Sunday morning the pitch would then be perfectly playable but the game had already been called off...and there was nobody to mark the lines out anyway ! Initially, that problem affected our pitch-sharing colleagues St. Mary's more than it did us (from luck of the arranged fixtures), but we suffered badly from that during Season 2012-2013 and it looks as if 2013-2014 could end up surpassing the current record of **eight** waterlogged pitch postponements for us in one season. (Season 2000-2001).*

- *This was when it snowed properly (in the North London area) for the first time in 19 years and we had our London Cup match against Yavruvatan continually called off and re-arranged for the following week. We ended up having to play them at their ground instead.*
- *This was also when Enfield Council started having a complete two-week break for their groundsmen during the Xmas period, thereby automatically meaning a two-week break for us, when previously we would have had fixtures arranged on dates such as the 22nd, 23rd, 28th, 29th, 30th Dec and the first Sunday in January from the 2nd Jan onwards. **That resulted in us going seven weeks without a game during the 2009-2010 Season, and that is still the worst run of 'postponements' in our history.***
